It's been a short week but a busy one as we begin our final half term in Reception. On Wednesday RL started their dance sessions with dance teacher Miss Valentine and we all enjoyed Music and Movement. The children have enjoyed exploring the new provision on offer as we begin our new topic 'Are all Minibeasts Scary?'

"Why does a spider need a web?"

Our Big Question this week has been 'Why does a spider need a web?' We have enjoyed the story of 'The Very Busy Spider' by Eric Carle where we met a spider who worked hard all day long to make her web. We have learnt that spiders are arachnids and that they even make their own by spinning a web to catch their food. We discussed the term 'habitat' and what it meant and considered the different habitats a range of minibeasts could be found in.






Mathematics

In Maths this week we have been working on our understanding of mass. We have used balance scales to compare the mass of two objects before using non-standard units to weigh objects from around the classroom. In our fluency lessons we have also been using a brand new piece of Mathematical equipment called a rekenrek. This has been another tool in helping our understanding of the composition of number.



Multiplication facts are needed in virtually all other areas of Mathematics therefore the more confidently children can recall these facts the easier they will find their Mathematics lessons as a barrier to learning is removed.



Just a reminder that the Lunt's Heath PTA have funded a subscription for every child to not only Maths Shed but the platform which also includes Spelling and Phonics Shed.


During lockdown we have found that the children's spelling ability was greatly impacted as it was difficult to teach and test spellings virtually.
