

Year 4 Summer 1 Newsletter 4L and 4H



This term the children will be exploring the following topics:

In **Science**, we will be looking at **Sound!** The children will be identifying how sounds are made, exploring pitch and volume as well as how to control it. We will also be finding patterns between the pitch of sound and a variety of objects. Children may even get the opportunity to make their own phone cups!

In **Maths**, some of the things we will be learning about are:

- Decimals
- Geometry
- Money

In our **Decimals** topic, the children will be writing in tenths and hundredths as well as dividing number by 10 and 100.

In our **Geometry** lessons, the children will be finding and measuring the area of shapes!

In our **Money** topic, the children will be writing and rounding amounts of money and solving money problems.

In PE we will be doing Dance - Egyptians (Indoors - Wednesday) and Athletics (Outdoors - Monday).

Dance - Egyptians, The children will be using a variety of dance techniques to produce a Egyptians themed dance to perform. They will look at timing, execution and performance skills.

In Athletics, the children will learn a variety of techniques such as sprinting, hurdles, jumping, overarm throw, relay races and throwing.

In English: For our Fiction text, we will be reading 'Egyptian Cinderella' by Shirley Climo. The children will be exploring how to write a diary entry by infering a characters' emotions, analysing roles of characters and using figurative language. and writing their own version of a folk tale. For our Non-Fiction text, we will be explaining 'Why was the River Nile important to the Egyptians?'. Finally, we will be studying the classic poetry 'Macavity the Mystery Cat' by T.S. Eliot.

For our **Geography** topic this term, we will be investigating the question: Where can I climb a mountain? (Mountains and Tourism)

For our **History** topic we will be exploring the question: **How advanced were the civilizations** around 3,000 years ago? (Ancient Egyptians)

In Art we will be completing a drawing inspired by Claude Monet

In R.E. we will be looking at Why do Muslims fast during Ramadan? (Islam)

Messages and Reminders:
