painting	The action or skill of using paint
tint	Adding white to a colour to make lighter tints
shade	Adding black to a colour to make darker shades.
techniques	Different ways of creating your artwork.
abstract art	Is more about the shapes, lines and colours rather than a realistic portrayal of a subject.

lines and texture	The feel or shape of a surface or substance; the smoothness, roughness, softness, etc. of something. cross-hatching: A method of showing shading by means of multiple small lines that intersect.
tone	Adding black and white (grey) to make darker or lighter tone

Tertiary colour - brown - mixing of three primary colours Primary and secondary colours can be mixed to create tints, shades and tones of the original hue (colour)
