Welcome back to our third and final term in Reception! Where has the time gone? We have had such a busy week but it has been lots of fun and the children have settled back in beautifully.

What could we grow in our garden?

Our Big Question this week has been 'What could we grow in our garden?' We have discussed how plants can grow and have planted our own cress seeds so we can make observations first hand. We have spoken about the different parts of a plant including the roots!







Mathematics

In Maths this week the children have been learning how to count on to add rather than counting all objects from the two groups. We have done this in lots of different practical ways such as counting on from 5 using our fingers, using ten frames and counters and on a number line.

In our Maths fluency sessions we have been refining our work on careful counting by applying our knowledge to bigger numbers. We have shared a number of ways to deal with counting larger quantities like lining the objects up or moving them as we count.

Reading

You may have noticed some new reading material in your child's book bag this week as children have been placed in new phonics groups following our latest progress check. Please do record any comments in your child's reading diary each time you read at home with them. We do value your feedback on how they are getting on at home and review your comments when we change their books- thank you.

Just a reminder that the Lunt's Heath PTA have funded a subscription for every child to not only Maths Shed but the platform which also includes Spelling and Phonics Shed.


During lockdown we have found that the children's spelling ability was greatly impacted as it was difficult to teach and test spellings virtually.
