PE Kit from September

Earlier this year the governors debated the merits of the school's PE kit, specifically the jogging over-suit that children wear for outdoor PE and have been wearing on PE days during the pandemic.

In supporting parents during the pandemic we have applied great flexibility, however from September we will be reverting with the strict standard of PE uniform once again being enforced.

COVID-19 update ~ September
