YEAR 2 – CHRISTMAS ACTIVITIES (To occupy children – e.g. colouring book, craft things)

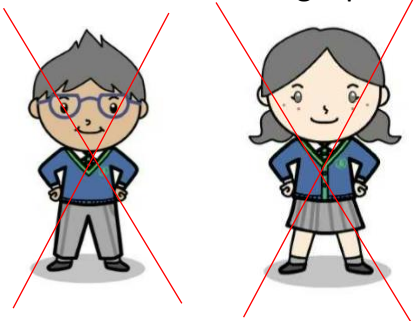
YEAR 3 – TOILETRIES – e.g. Things you could use as an emergency back up present
