RE Focus	Christianity (Church)	Year 6	Term: Summer 2 nd Half Term

What? (Key Questions)
Is life like a journey? If life is like a journey, what's the destination?
What? (Key Knowledge)
Explore what it is that Christians believe gives their lives purpose and meaning. This builds on their prior learning about how Christians are guided to live. The children will learn about the effect that belief in salvation brought about by Jesus' death and resurrection has. They will discover how the act of confessing sins and seeking reconciliation and forgiveness restores relationships with others and with God in the eyes of the believer, leading to faith in life after death. The children will have opportunities to reflect on the importance of forgiveness to them.
Key Knowledge
The word church can mean a group of Christian people.
The Bible commands a central place in the life of the Church and the individual Christian. It provides guidance and inspiration and is regarded as the 'Word of God'.
The Old Testament is a collection of books that were written before the life of Jesus. It contains the rules which Christians should live by, contained in the Ten Commandments in the book of Exodus.
The Ten Commandments: I am the LORD thy God. No other gods before me. No graven images or likenesses. Not take the LORD's name in vain. Remember the Sabbath day. Honour thy father and thy mother. Thou shalt not kill. Thou shalt not commit adultery.

Exploration of religion
