	<b>ONE ADULT</b> – in reducing the foot fall within the locality and in helping us to maintain as much social distancing as possible we kindly ask that only one adult accompanies your child / children to and from school.
	<b>FACE COVERINGS</b> – the wearing of face coverings when entering school grounds is stipulated across Halton by the Director. We want you and your child to feel as comfortable as possible, especially during peak times of drop-offs and pick-ups, and ask for your full cooperation with this request.
	<b>SOCIAL DISTANCING</b> – this remains a significantly important part of our safety strategy; please adhere to this principle at all times whilst waiting to drop-off and pick-up.
	<b>AVOID CONGESTION</b> – to help maintain safe social distancing please remind yourself of the staggered entry and exit procedures and times that have been allocated avoiding congestion and gathering in social groups.
	<b>COVID-19 SYMPTOMS</b> – if your child is experiencing any COVID-19 symptoms they should be kept off school as a precaution and you should inform us immediately. Your child will need to be tested negative to be re-admitted to school.
